Mac Asphalt Plant - More Senior Citizens Speak Out!

Local Seniors Say Plant Should Be Moved to Non-Residential Area

Jeffersonville, August 31, 2010: The MAC Construction & Excavating asphalt plant is once again in the news. The Indiana Construction Information Network (INCIN) today released another *Eye on Construction* video report in which more local senior citizens speak out about issues surrounding the plant and its location near a residential area.

The asphalt plant, long the subject of complaints by local residents, was also named as a defendant in a lawsuit filed in Clark County Circuit Court on August 18 by local residents and property owners.

The most recent INCIN video features interviews with local seniors who tell very personal stories of health concerns about the fumes emanating from the plant and loud noises coming from the plant late at night.

The seniors also state that they don't feel that Jeffersonville city government has done enough to address their concerns. Ultimately, the seniors say they would like to see the asphalt plant moved to a non-residential area.
